

Security Badge Requirements:

All persons entering the Yucca Mountain Project (DOE, BSC, and Contractor) facilities must have an access card *and* a DOE Standard Badge or Visitor Badge

In order to obtain an access card and badge, you must bring two forms of identification, one document from each list below. One or the other must be a State or Federal Government-issued picture identification document. Non-picture identification must be an original or certified copy.

One + One

CITIZENSHIP

1. U.S. Passport (current or expired)
2. Certificate of Naturalization
3. Certificate of U.S. Citizenship
4. Birth Certificate
5. Report of Birth Abroad of a U.S. Citizen (Form FS 240)
6. Record of Military Processing-Armed Forces of the U.S. (DDForm 1966, must reflect U.S. Citizenship)
7. Certificate of Birth (Form FS 545 or DS 1350)

IDENTITY

1. U.S. Passport (current or expired)
2. Certificate of Naturalization
3. Certificate of U.S. Citizenship
4. Drivers license of U.S. state
5. ID card issued by federal, state, or local agencies with bearer photo
6. U.S. Military ID card or draft record
7. Military dependent's card
8. Native American tribal document
9. School ID card with bearer photo
10. Voter's registration card
11. U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card

Failure to provide two forms of identification will result in your inability to obtain a DOE Security Badge.

Please be aware, any non-U.S. citizen is considered a foreign national. Processing time to obtain foreign national access approval and badge issuance requires 4 to 8 weeks prior to the start of work.
